### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

Remember that May 1<sup>st</sup> is the Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord. This feast moves with Easter but it is always forty days after Easter and always on a Thursday. There will be Mass on Wednesday evening April 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM and May 1<sup>st</sup> at 6:45 AM 8:30 AM and 12:00 Noon. All the Masses will take place in the church as well as all weekday morning Masses after May first. The last Mass in the parish center will be Wednesday morning April 30<sup>th</sup> until the winter rolls around again.

Buy your tickets today for the Spaghetti Dinner that will be take place next Saturday from 4:30 PM till 7:30 PM in the parish center.
