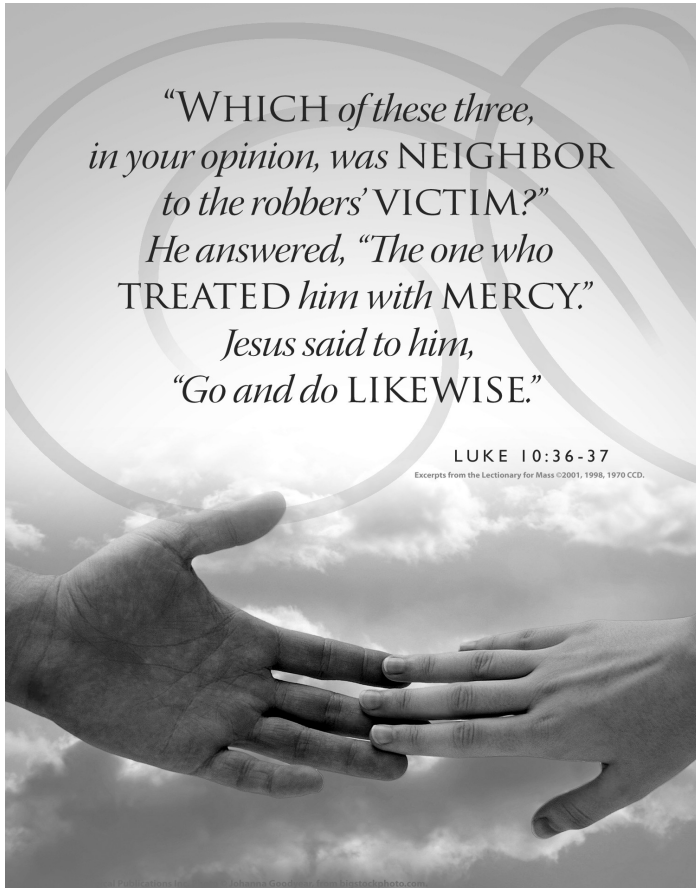

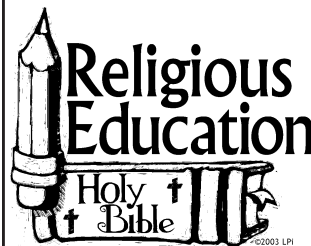
**Family Day at the Ballpark**
